Relational Thinking: The Yeast Strategy

(or how to transform society without making a noise about it)



Dr Michael Schluter (CBE) is an economist, relational thinker and social entrepreneur. He is Chairman of Relational Research, a not-for-profit company which believes in the importance of relationships for social and personal wellbeing and seeks to enable organisations and governments to build effective stakeholder relationships and combat the causes of relational poverty. He has co-authored '*Transforming Capitalism from Within*' and '*The Relational Manager*' among a number of other books and papers. Michael is an experienced speaker who has addressed audiences all over the world.

Many Christians feel boxed in. On the one hand they know the Bible teaches they should seek to transform society as salt & light; on the other hand they are finding this increasingly difficult due to growing resistance to Christian influence. The Yeast Strategy is a fresh Christian-inspired approach based on Relational Thinking to influence the way people think and make decisions in public policy and in organisations - without stirring up the resistance which is so often encountered.

Michael Schluter will explain the Yeast Strategy and how it works, with practical case studies of how it has made a difference in practice.
